One remarkable 14+ acre vineyard, dating back to the mid-1990s, gracefully rests within the northwest borders of Graton, in the esteemed Green Valley sub-appellation of the Russian River Valley.

WINEMAKING

The hand-picked fruit from our Green Valley Girls Vineyard exemplifies our commitment to quality. We carefully selected both clones on the same night, intending to co-ferment them at our winery. Our objective with this wine is to highlight the unique characteristics that emerge when these clones are combined early in the process. By co-fermenting, we extract a plethora of flavors, aromas, textures, and tannins. This Pinot Noir is truly special, deviating from our usual fermentation and blending methods, creating a delightful experience for both winemakers and consumers alike. Upon completion of fermentation, the wine was transferred to French oak barrels, with 75% being new, resulting in a harmonious blend of enticing baking spices on both the nose and palate.

TASTING NOTES

With delicate florals that dance on your nose, accompanied by enticing aromas of plum and currant, this wine is a true sensory delight. The palate bursts with vibrant red berries, cranberries, and hints of dried herbs and baking spice. It's an exquisite balance of fruit, acidity, and spice, with plush tannins and medium acidity that linger on your taste buds, creating a captivating and lingering finish. Whether you enjoy it now or let it age, this 2022 vintage is a true gem that will captivate your senses and take you on a journey through its evolving flavors.
