VINEYARD

Dutton Ranch manages 80+ distinct vineyards in the picturesque Russian River Valley. Our vineyards are Sonoma County Sustainable Farm Friendly certified, showcasing our commitment to environmentally conscious practices. Each vineyard contributes to the exquisite flavor and character of our wine. The Green Valley Vineyard offers dark and rich fruit, while the Campbell Vineyard adds earthiness and acidity. Lastly, the Manzana Vineyard imparts delightful red fruit notes with a hint of cherry cola aromas. Meet Karmen Isabella, part of our esteemed Sisters Selection. This wine embodies Karmen Isabella's essence - an "old soul" in our family - featuring quiet complexity and remarkable depth of flavors.

WINEMAKING

This wine was meticulously crafted, with multiple night-time passes in the vineyard. Each lot was fermented separately to extract the perfect flavors. During the process, it underwent a cold soak for 3 days and received gentle punch downs once daily. Throughout primary fermentation, punch downs and pump overs occurred up to three times daily. After fermentation, each lot was aged separately in 100% French oak. Finally, the wine was expertly blended, resulting in a blend that incorporated 45% new oak.

TASTING NOTES

A masterful expression of vineyard treasures. Delight your senses as the nose lures you in with vibrant red fruit notes and graceful floral aromas. On the palate, indulge in its velvety smoothness and a lingering finish that harmonizes delicate tannins and refreshing acidity, reminiscent of the timeless elegance of Burgundian Pinot Noir. Prepare to be captivated as flavors evolve, revealing deeper, juicy fruits like raspberry and cherry.
