2017 Kyndall's Reserve Chardonnay "With fruit sourced from all of Dutton Ranch's finest Chardonnay Vineyards we fermented equal parts in our concrete Eggs, stainless steel and French oak. The nose opens up with super expressive Chardonnay aromas of apricot, white peach, lemon, vanilla and hints of cuties. The aromas follow through to the palate with rich dried apricot surrounded by pear and lemon zest.

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## KARMEN ISABELLA PINOT NOIR

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### **2017 Karmen Isabella Pinot Noir**

#### **The Tasting Panel Magazine ~ The Somm Journal - 93 Points**

2017 Karmen Isabella “Sourced from three vineyards in the Russian River Valley – out of the more than 80 that the winery farms that are Sonoma County Sustainably Farmed and Fish-Friendly – they are also all dry farmed. The Karmen Isabella Pinot Noir is aged 11 months in French oak. Cherries in tilled soil, red tea and savory baking spices play a part in the intriguing aromatics. Expansive flavors of cocoa and pomegranate set in a “deliciousness” along with a sumptuous texture. Round in the mouth, notes of chili pepper are subdued but still integrate with cedar, cinnamon and orange peel.”

Medium-bodied, it fills the mouth with savory red and blue fruits and spicy accents, framed by grainy tannins and finishing juicy and spicy. Yum!" 250 cases produced.

2017 Thomas Road Pinot Noir "Pale to medium ruby, the 2017 Pinot Noir Thomas Road Vineyard opens with earthy notions of woodsmoke, pipe tobacco and graphite with wild blackberry and crushed black cherry. Medium-bodied, it's earthy in the mouth with concentrated black fruits, firm, grainy tannins and juicy freshness lifting the spicy finish. This needs some more time in bottle." 230 cases produced.

#### **California Grapevine - 92 Points**

2017 Thomas Road Vineyard Pinot Noir "Medium ruby; attractive, fragrant, cherry and red berry fruit aroma with earthy notes and hints of cocoa powder, cinnamon, dried herbs, and forest floor; medium-full body; rich, textured, elegantly styled, red fruit flavors with bright acidity, herbal notes, and a silky mouthfeel; medium to medium-full tannin; lingering aftertaste. Very appealing now, though should reward several more years of bottle aging. Very highly recommended."

2017 Thomas Road Pinot Noir "Thomas Road Vineyard is also in Green Valley. Here, it yielded an exceptional wine: full bodied, concentrated, and young; a wine with ripe, exotic aromas/flavors (black licorice, saffron, black currant, black tea, clove, sage, toasty oak), evident tannin, good balance, and a very long finish. Warrants at least 2-3 years more of bottle aging. Excellent value. Five day cold soak. Aged 10 months in French oak barrels, 40% new. Dijon clone 115. 230 cases. 14.5% [2022-2026]"

Medium-bodied, it offers great concentration of layered red and blue fruit, spices and earthy nuances in the mouth, with soft, grainy tannins and a long, layered finish." 231 cases produced.

The Russian River Valley in Sonoma County, California, is home to wineries and vineyards with a mosaic of finely tuned, finesse-driven Pinot Noirs and Chardonnays. Within this heartland of forested rolling hills and complex soils is a community of multigenerational families who have bred winemaking and grape growing into the natural beauty.
