Our treasure, the Blushing Sisters, is a delightful Pinot Noir Rosé named after Tracy and Joe's three daughters: Kyndall, Kylie, and Karmen Isabella. With a six-generation legacy, the Dutton Estate proudly leads alongside fellow grape growers. Our vineyards hold Sonoma County Sustainably-Farmed and FishFriendly certifications, reflecting our commitment to environmental stewardship. Through dry-farming techniques, we consistently yield grapes with an enchanting and authentic character, cherished in our history.

WINEMAKING

Our exclusive Blushing Sister's Rosé of Pinot Noir is meticulously crafted from select vineyards in the cool Russian River Valley. Harvested from the renowned Dutton Ranch's Manzana, Green Valley, Thomas Road, Jewell Block, and Kozlowski Vineyards, this limited production wine showcases the finest quality. It is made using the Saignée method, where fresh, expressive pink juice is carefully drawn off the top of just crushed Pinot Noir tanks and left to macerate for a refined 4-6 hours. The juice is then delicately fermented in small lots, using stainless steel, allowing for a gentle development of flavors over a period of 14 days. To add depth and complexity, the wine is aged in neutral oak barrels until it reaches optimal maturity, ensuring a truly remarkable experience upon bottling.

TASTING NOTES

A symphony of fragrances awaits as peach, melon, and fresh strawberry entice your senses. Savor the same delightful aromas as they dance upon your palate, accompanied by the lusciousness of white peach flesh and the sweetness of ripe strawberries. Feel the vibrant notes of pink grapefruit and cantaloupe intertwined with subtle hints of lychee nut and delicate mineral complexities.
